Welcome to the 131500 mobile internet service

This new service gives you immediate access to the range of primary 131500 Transport Infoline services when you are on the move, including:

- Late breaking news
- Next service timetables – Train, Bus or Ferry
- Transit stop timetables
- Service changes
- Highlight events

This user guide provides you a description of the services available and instructions on how to access the information you are looking for.

The mobile service information is a simplified version of the main 131500 website, www.131500.info. The timetable, service news and event information are updated regularly on both services.

How can I access the service using my mobile phone?

The 131500 mobile internet service has been designed to allow access from as many mobile phone handsets as possible.

Telstra and Optus mobile customers with internet access enabled can now use the service by entering the web address into their mobile phone, following these steps:

1. Select the option on your phone to 'go to' a web address
2. Enter the web address '<http://mobile.131500.info>', select OK^{*}
3. Enter the 131500 mobile internet site homepage.



1. Breaking News

The 'Breaking News' section presents details of current reported service disruptions affecting the Transport network. These details are updated regularly and provide details on expected delays and alternative travel arrangements.

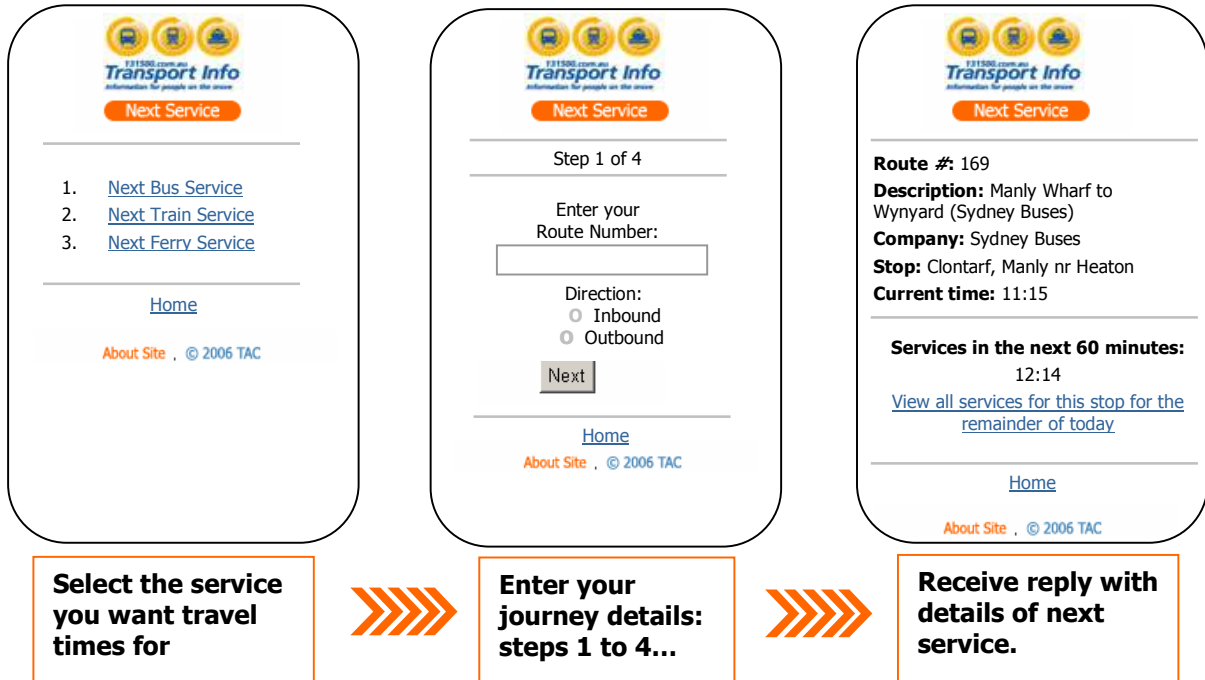
2. Next Services:

This link will allow you to search for timetable information for the next available bus, train or ferry.

The timetable search results include:

- CityRail Trains (including weekend trackwork)
- All Buses in Greater Sydney (Government and Private)
- All Sydney Ferries services.

The timetable results are based on the published timetables and may be subject to operating conditions and service disruptions.

3. Transit Stop Timetables

Customers may also obtain their timetable information for an individual transit stop (Bus or Ferry). This may be the best when the check service times to your destination when multiple routes operate via your bus stop.

Transit Stops can be searched by either landmarks, suburbs or, if you know it, your bus stop number.

Transit Stop numbers are displayed on each bus stop in the Sydney Buses area.



4. Highlight Events


This feature allows you to search through upcoming special events and find details such as time/date, venue details and relevant transport links to assist you in getting to the event.

This service may also be useful if you are traveling in an area a major event is taking place. As major events can sometimes affect the transport services in those areas.
