Bus services at Liverpool Transport Interchange with suburbs in the local area and also to Glenfield, Campbelltown and Parramatta.

Accessing public transport has been made easy by closely linking the buses with the entrance to Liverpool Railway Station, making it safer and easier for customers to make their connections.

You can catch one of the many buses departing Liverpool Transport Interchange to south western suburbs. Services to major centres depart frequently and many operate from early morning until late at night.

This guide gives a general description of bus services using the interchange as well as general information about the facilities available.

Bus Stops



Bus stops are located at the bus interchange directly next to the station. The bus stops feature timetables, shelter and comfortable seating.

Buses depart from thirteen stands in the interchange. See the map shown for the location of the various facilities in the interchange area. A detailed bus route departure listing is shown on the page overleaf.

Bus Tickets

For travel on most private buses, you can pay a cash fare to the driver. Some bus operators offer multi-ride electronic fare cards. For information on these please contact your local bus operator.

Tickets that are purchased on board buses should be kept for the duration of your trip to avoid being fined by a ticket inspector.

NightRide Bus Services



NightRide Routes N30 and N50 replace train services between approximately 12am and 4:30am daily, and operate between Macarthur and the City. These services depart from a designated bus stand on bus platform A.

Trains



From Liverpool Station you can catch one of the many train services operated by CityRail. These include the South line, Cumberland line, Inner West line and Bankstown line. For fastest journeys to the City from Liverpool, take the South Line via Fairfield and Granville. For travel to Parramatta and Blacktown when direct Cumberland Line trains do not operate, take a South Line train to Granville and change for Western Line services.

Train services operate frequently seven days a week from early morning until late at night. For timetable and fare information call Transport Info on 131 500 or visit www.131500.com.au

Taxis
