Metrobus services operate 7 days a week

Metrobuses depart every 10 minutes during morning and afternoon peak periods, every 15 minutes during the day, every 20 mins at night and on weekends.

Ticket Information

It is recommended you buy your ticket before boarding the bus. This will save you time and if you purchase a Traveller, it will save you money.

For unlimited travel, transfers and use of bus, train and ferries, purchase a MyMulti ticket. All MyMulti tickets can be used on regular private, government and T-way buses plus regular government ferries throughout greater Sydney. The three MyMulti zones (1, 2 and 3) represent the limit of rail travel. Visit www.131500.com.au for info on MyZone ticketing or phone Transport Info on 131500.

Bus stops used by Sydney Buses in Sydney CBD and Parramatta Interchange are Prepay-only from 7am to 7pm weekdays.

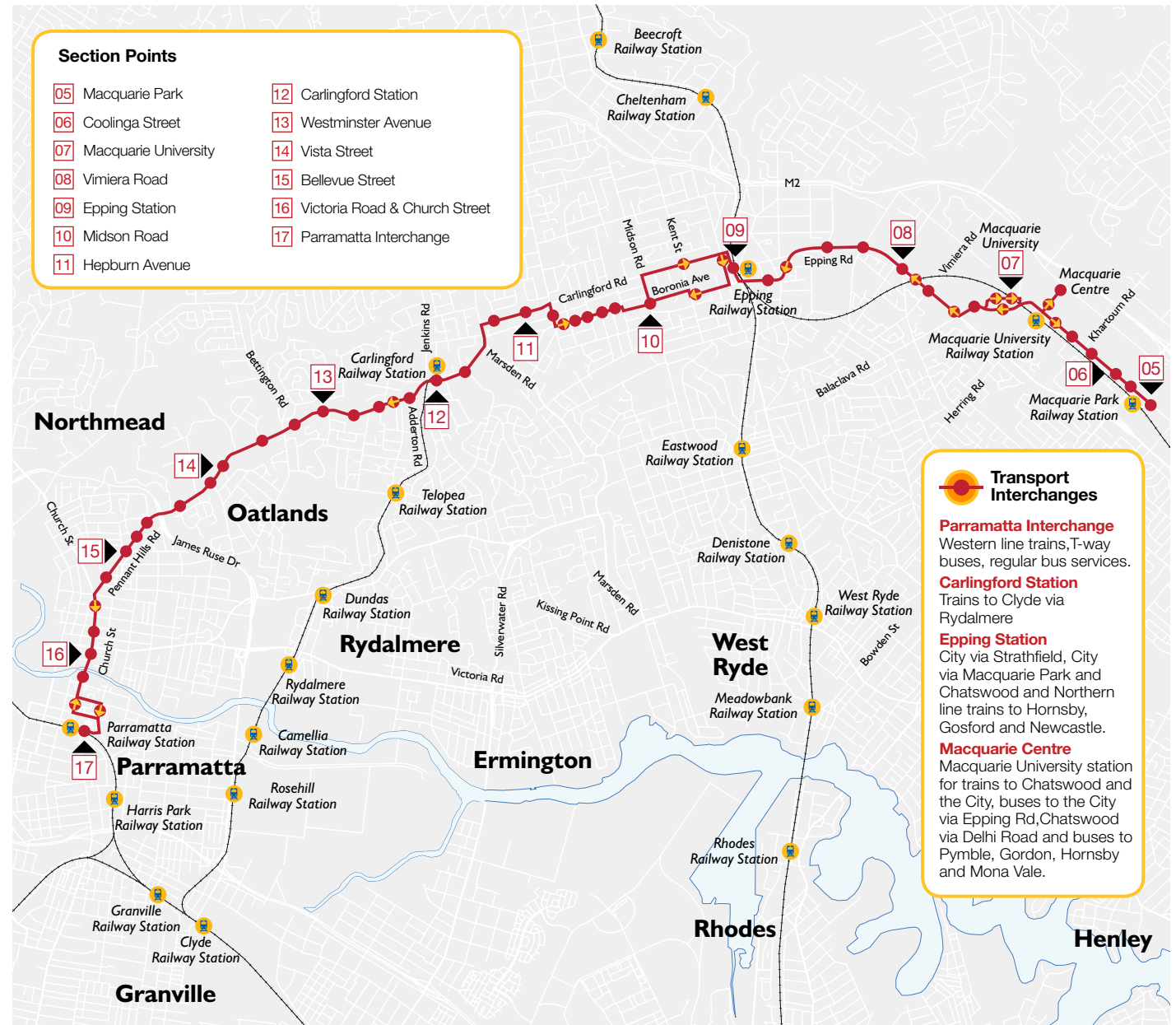

Here are just a few of the many places accessible on Metrobus m54

Parramatta - Parramatta Railway Station. Local bus services, Westfield Shopping Centre, historical sites, cafés and restaurants

Victoria Road - Short walk to Parramatta Stadium

Carlingford - Carlingford Railway Station, trains to Rydalmere and Clyde

Rembrandt Street - Carlingford Court shopping centre

Epping - Epping Railway Station, trains to the City via Strathfield, Chatswood, Hornsby and Northern line to Gosford and Newcastle

Macquarie University

Macquarie Centre - Macquarie University Railway Station. Shopping, theatres and ice rink

Macquarie Park - Macquarie Park Railway Station. Business park and commercial area:- short walk to Foxtel, Optus, Hyundai, Philips, Dupont and Orix corporate offices

Historic Parramatta

Historic homes and churches tell the story of the early settlers and the important role Parramatta has played in shaping Australia.

Take the Harris Park Heritage Walk and visit historic homes that are now museums, sites include:-

- Old Government House, built in 1799, home to the early governors of NSW; and
- Elizabeth Farm, home of Australia's first pastoralists, John and Elizabeth Macarthur.

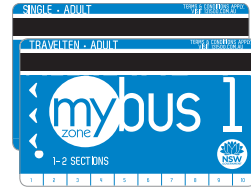

MyBus - Single and TravelTen

Choosing the right ticket is as easy as 1, 2, 3.



MyBus1
for trips up to 2 sections in length.

MyBus2
for trips that are 3 to 5 sections in length.

MyBus3
for trips 6 sections or longer.

MyBus TravelTen is an economical 10-ride ticket which can be used on both government and private buses. With a TravelTen you get ten rides for the price of eight and the ticket remains valid until all ten rides are used. TravelTen tickets are also transferable, and can be used to pay for travelling companions.

If you use a MyBus TravelTen on a government bus, simply dip the ticket in the green ticket validator as usual. If you use a MyBus TravelTen on a private bus, simply give your ticket to the bus driver for validation.

TravelTen tickets are only valid for a combined total of 10 trips.

Single ride tickets are available and can be used for one trip on either a government or private bus service.

MyMulti - Weekly, Quarterly and Yearly



All MyMulti tickets (1,2,3 and DayPass) provide unlimited travel on Metrobuses, private buses, Sydney Buses and Sydney Ferries in the greater Sydney area.*

For travel by CityRail trains in an area bounded by Chatswood, Bondi Junction, Rockdale, Bardwell Park, Canterbury and Croydon use a MyMulti1.

MyMulti2 extends rail travel to an area bounded by Seven Hills, Carlingford, Hornsby, Liverpool, Holsworthy, Engadine and Carlingbah.

MyMulti3 and DayPass cover the greater Sydney area, which includes the Blue Mountains, Illawarra and the Hunter.

*MyBus and MyMulti tickets exclude travel on Premium Services such as Explorer and special event buses, private ferries and cruises. At AirportLink stations a separate access fee applies.

There are over 170 ticket outlets in the Sydney CBD and over 1500 across the Sydney region.

Tickets are available from outlets displaying the MyZone/PrePay sign.
