

## metrobus 10 high frequency service connecting Leichhardt with Maroubra Junction via Park Street, Sydney

Metrobuses depart every 10 minutes during morning and afternoon peak periods, every 15 minutes during the day and every 20 minutes at night and on weekends.

### Weekdays

The first Metrobus leaves from Maroubra Junction at 6.33am and from Leichhardt at 6.43am and then approximately every 10 minutes during morning and afternoon peak hours.

Metrobus runs every 15-20 minutes during the day and in the evening.

The last Metrobus leaves from Maroubra Junction at 8.05pm and from Leichhardt at 8.19pm.

### Weekends and Public Holidays

The first Metrobus leaves from Maroubra Junction at 7.32am and from Leichhardt at 7.38am and then approximately every 20 minutes.

The last Metrobus leaves from Maroubra Junction at 7.55pm and from Leichhardt at 7.55pm.

### Sydney Buses cross city network

Route m10 provides a direct link from Leichhardt via Parramatta Road to Sydney Uni, Broadway and the City to Maroubra Junction via Anzac Parade and UNSW.

Metrobus m10 connects with Route m30 at Broadway for trips to Newtown, Enmore and Sydenham or in George Street for trips to Mosman via the Warringah Expressway and Military Road.

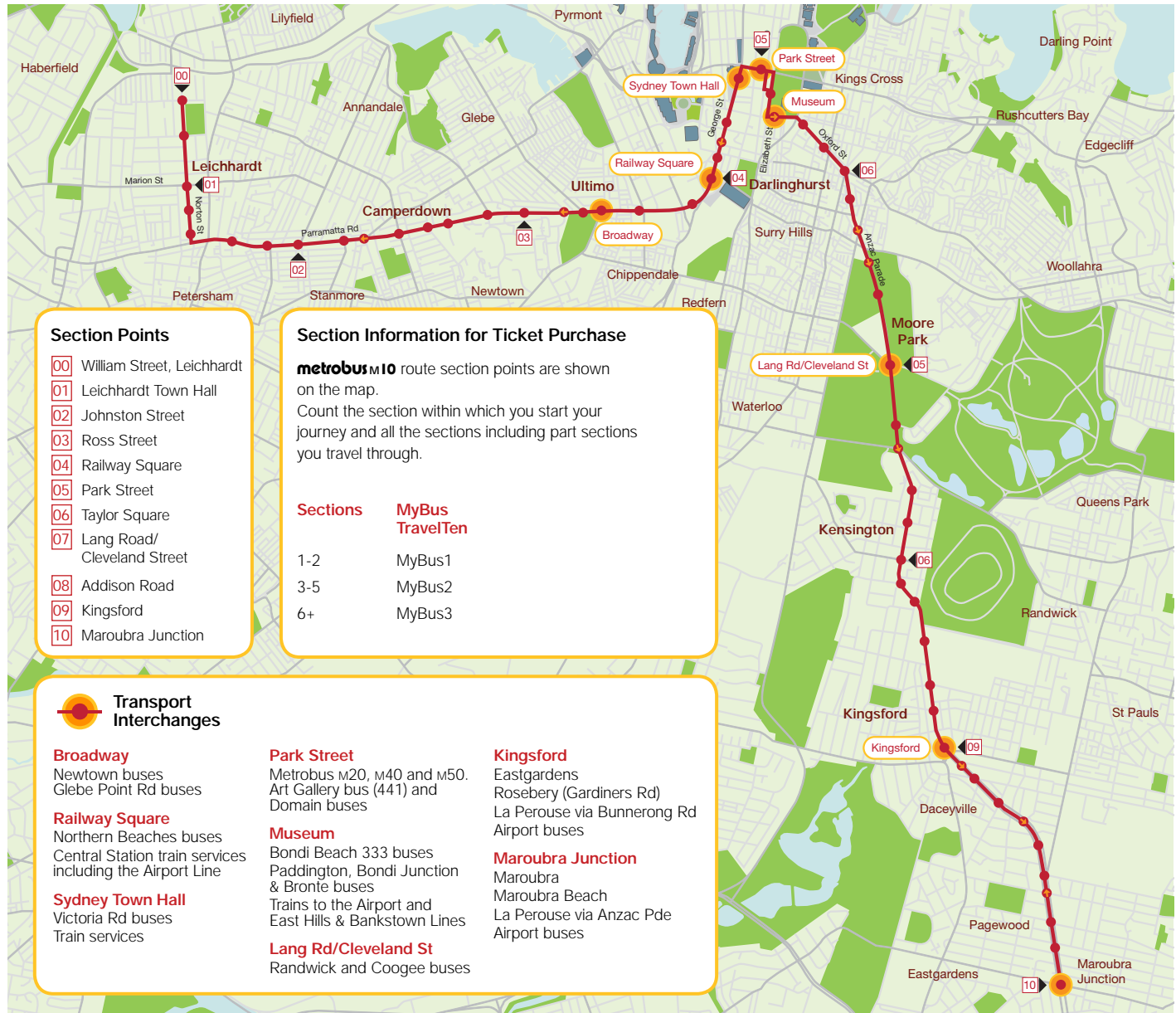
Metrobus m10 connects in Park Street for Routes m20, m40 and m50 or a short walk to Druitt St for m52.

Route m20 northbound travels to Gore Hill via North Sydney and the Pacific Highway and southbound to Mascot via Elizabeth Street and Victoria Park.

Route m40 northbound travels to Chatswood via the freeway and Willoughby Road and to the East to Bondi Junction via Oxford Street and Paddington.

Route m50 westbound travels to Drummoyne via Victoria Road and Eastbound to Coogee via Surry Hills, UNSW and Randwick.

Route m52 can be accessed on Druitt St for trips to Gladesville, Ryde and Parramatta via Victoria Road.



## metrobus m10 - features

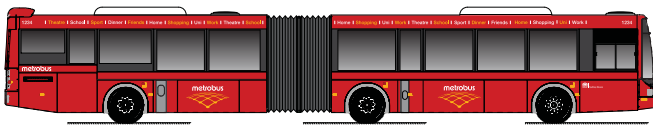
Metrobus m10 is a PrePay-only service. PrePay simply means purchasing a ticket before boarding the bus.

Each Metrobus m10 has low floor, wheelchair access and priority seating for elderly and less mobile passengers.

An easy to follow route and on-board next stop displays and audio announcements make travelling on Metrobus m10 an easy-to-use alternative.

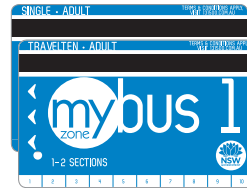

## MyBus - Single and TravelTen

Choosing the right ticket is as easy as 1, 2, 3.



### MyBus1

for trips up to 2 sections in length.

### MyBus2

for trips that are 3 to 5 sections in length.

### MyBus3

for trips 6 sections or longer.

MyBus TravelTen is an economical 10-ride ticket which can be used on both government and private buses. With a TravelTen you get ten rides for the price of eight and the ticket remains valid until all ten rides are used. TravelTen tickets are also transferable, and can be used to pay for travelling companions.

If you use a MyBus TravelTen on a government bus, simply dip the ticket in the green ticket validator as usual. If you use a MyBus TravelTen on a private bus, simply give your ticket to the bus driver for validation.

TravelTen tickets are only valid for a combined total of 10 trips.

Single ride tickets are available and can be used for one trip on either a government or private bus service.

## MyMulti - Weekly, Quarterly and Yearly



All MyMulti tickets (1,2,3 and DayPass) provide unlimited travel on Metrobuses, private buses, Sydney Buses and Sydney Ferries in the greater Sydney area.\*

Use MyMulti1 to include travel by CityRail trains in an area bounded by Chatswood, Bondi Junction, Rockdale, Bardwell Park, Canterbury and Croydon.

Use MyMulti2 for rail travel in an area bounded by Seven Hills, Carlingford, Hornsby, Liverpool, Holsworthy, Engadine and Caringbah.

Use MyMulti 3 and MyMulti DayPass for travel in the Greater Sydney Area, which includes the Blue Mountains, Illawarra and the Hunter.

\*MyBus and MyMulti tickets exclude travel on Premium Services such as: Explorer and special event buses, private ferries and cruises. At AirportLink stations a separate access fee applies.

**There are over 170 ticket outlets in the Sydney CBD and over 1500 across the Sydney region.**

**Tickets are available from outlets displaying the MyZone/PrePay sign.**
