

metrobus m41 high frequency service connecting Hurstville, Bexley North, Campsie, Burwood, Concord, Rhodes, Ryde, Top Ryde, North Ryde, Macquarie Park, Macquarie Centre and Marsfield

Metrobus services operate 7 days a week

Metrobuses depart every 10 minutes during morning and afternoon peak periods, every 15 minutes during the day, every 20 minutes at night and on weekends.

metrobus m41 - features

Each Metrobus m41 has low floor, wheelchair access and priority seating for elderly and less mobile passengers.

An easy to follow route with bus stop names, on-board next stop displays and audio announcements make travelling on Metrobus m41 an easy-to-use alternative.



Ticketing

It is recommended you buy a ticket before boarding the bus. This will save you time and if you use a TravelTen will save you money.

There is a range of Myzone tickets. MyBus tickets can be used on Metrobus, blue and white government buses, T-way buses and private buses throughout Sydney.

MyMutli passes can be used on train, bus and ferry.

Metrobus m41 route section points are shown on the map. Count the sections within which you start your journey and all the sections you travel through (including part sections).

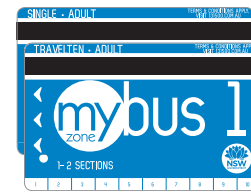

MyBus - Single and TravelTen

Choosing the right ticket is as easy as 1, 2, 3.



MyBus1
for trips up to 2 sections in length.

MyBus2
for trips that are 3 to 5 sections in length.

MyBus3
for trips 6 sections or longer.

MyBus TravelTen is an economical 10-ride ticket which can be used on both government and private buses. With a TravelTen you get ten rides for the price of eight and the ticket remains valid until all ten rides are used. TravelTen tickets are also transferable, and can be used to pay for travelling companions.

If you use a MyBus TravelTen on a government bus, simply dip the ticket in the green ticket validator as usual. If you use a MyBus TravelTen on a private bus, simply give your ticket to the bus driver for validation.

TravelTen tickets are only valid for a combined total of 10 trips.

Single ride tickets are available and can be used for one trip on either a government or private bus service.

MyMulti - Weekly, Quarterly and Yearly



All MyMulti tickets (1,2,3 and DayPass) provide unlimited travel on Metrobuses, private buses, Sydney Buses and Sydney Ferries in the greater Sydney area.*

Use MyMulti1 to include travel by CityRail trains in an area bounded by Chatswood, Bondi Junction, Rockdale, Bardwell Park, Canterbury and Croydon.

Use MyMulti2 for rail travel in an area bounded by Seven Hills, Carlingford, Hornsby, Liverpool, Holsworthy, Engadine and Caringbah.

Use MyMulti 3 and MyMulti DayPass for travel in the Greater Sydney Area, which includes the Blue Mountains, Illawarra and the Hunter.

*MyBus and MyMulti tickets exclude travel on Premium Services such as: Explorer and special event buses, private ferries and cruises. At Sydney airport stations a separate access fee applies.

There are over 170 ticket outlets in the Sydney CBD and over 1500 across the Sydney region.

Tickets are available from outlets displaying the MyZone/PrePay sign.



Places accessible on metrobus m41

Here are just a few of the many places accessible on Metrobus m41

Macquarie University - stops on either side of the campus plus sports field and Macquarie University Hospital

Macquarie Centre (Waterloo Road) - Macquarie University railway station, shopping, movie theatre, ice rink, bus interchange and m54

Macquarie Park - Macquarie Park railway station and stops for the North Ryde business park and commercial area

Top Ryde - Shopping centre and bus interchange for Victoria Road buses and m52

Mary Street stop - Short walk to Rhodes railway station and access to Rhodes Shopping Centre

Concord Hospital - Concord Repatriation and General Hospital

Concord Library - Readers Café and Library

Concord Shops - Concord shopping and café precinct, buses to Mortlake, Cabarita and Five Dock

Burwood - Burwood Railway Station, western line trains, Westfield Shopping Centre, Burwood Plaza, café and restaurants and regional centre. Bus interchange to South Strathfield, Five Dock, Croydon Park, Mortlake, Cabarita and m90

Campsie - Campsie Railway Station, Bankstown line, shopping precinct and bus services into the inner and south west

William St, Clemton Park - buses to Earlwood, Marrickville, Newtown and City

Bexley North Railway Station - East Hills and Airport line connection

Bexley North - Swimming Centre and golf course

Hurstville - Hurstville Railway Station, shopping, café's, restaurants and m91
