

FAMILY FUNDAY SUNDAY TICKET TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Family Funday Sunday tickets offer you a flat fare of \$2.50 for travel around the greater Sydney region on CityRail services, Metro Light Rail services, Sydney Buses, Newcastle Buses, Sydney and Newcastle ferries (not including private ferries) and participating private bus operators.

You can buy Family Funday Sunday tickets if you are in a family group that's travelling together. A family group must include a minimum of one adult and one child. A ticket is required for each family member over the age of three.

A child is anyone under 16 years, i.e. up to 15 years or a school student aged 16, 17 or 18 attending a NSW or ACT school and in possession of a current 202 card or equivalent, valid private bus school pass.

Children under the age of four travel free and their parents are entitled to purchase Family Funday Sunday tickets when travelling with them.

Buy your Family Funday Sunday tickets on Sundays from bus drivers (excluding PrePay services), CityRail stations, ferry ticket offices, or any day of the week from authorised newsagents, 7-elevens and convenience stores.

Family Funday Sunday tickets for use on PrePay buses are available from MyZone ticket resellers. You can't buy Family Funday Sunday tickets from the drivers of PrePay Only buses or train replacement (trackwork) buses. Family Funday Sunday tickets are not sold on board Metro Light Rail services, so you'll need to buy one from a MyZone ticket reseller before you board.

Some services are excluded from the Family Funday Sunday scheme. These are the Monorail, private ferry operators and special event buses. A station access fee also applies if you use Domestic Airport or International Airport stations.

Seats on CityRail coach services between Lithgow and Bathurst are subject to availability. If you wish to travel between Lithgow and Bathurst, you need to buy your tickets and then book seats via staff at a CityRail ticket office or by calling 13 22 32. You do not need to book seats on CityRail coach services between Wollongong and Bundanoon.

Family Funday Sunday tickets are available from and accepted by the public transport providers listed below.

Note: most bus companies and ticket resellers will issue Pensioner Excursion Tickets to family groups as these have the same boundaries as Family Funday Sunday tickets.
